# Senior Finals Week of April 11-14

Senior Finals occur Monday through Thursday (April 11-14). Finals are taken in core courses only, and those students with an 85% average or better are exempt. Those students taking Advanced Placement (AP) courses will take the corresponding AP Exam. There are no final exams for Advancement Placement (AP) courses. Seniors are allowed to dress down, but must be dressed appropriately.

# Starting April 11 AP Students will continue to meet with their teachers during finals week, unless it conflicts with a final.

# Senior Service April 25 - May 12

After Senior Finals have been completed, seniors are no longer required to attend daily classes (apart from Advanced Placement (AP) courses which seniors are required to attend) and are provided time to complete their Senior Christian Service requirements.

The service hours to meet our graduation requirements are based upon a student's schedule.

- Seniors with three or more AP courses are required to complete a minimum of 50 hours.
- Seniors with one or two AP courses are required to complete a minimum of 70 hours.
- Seniors who are not enrolled in AP courses must complete a minimum of 90 hours.

# Advanced Placement Exams May 2-13

Seniors enrolled in Advancement Placement (AP) courses are required to continue attending these classes until the AP exam is given. Seniors are allowed to dress down, but must be dressed appropriately.
