Thank you for volunteering to coordinate a reunion for members of your graduation class. These guidelines have been prepared to ensure a successful reunion that will benefit both alumni and Malden Catholic High School.

What volunteers can expect from Malden Catholic

- MC will provide a mailing list to the organizer of alumni from that class year. (Mailing lists are only as accurate as the information provided by alumni to the school.)
- MC will send an email blast to alumni for whom we have an email address regarding your reunion.
- MC will post your event on our Facebook page.
- If the organizer is creating a custom-designed invitation, upon request Malden Catholic will provide an approved logo and brand standards.

What MC can expect from the Volunteers

- Select a venue and date for your reunion. Please check with a member of the Advancement staff to avoid conflicts with other school-related activities.
- Gather a committee of 5 or 6 classmates to make phone calls, send emails and/or use social media to encourage attendance. Your committee will be critical in driving attendance.
- Prepare a preliminary budget for your event and set a fee that will cover all costs.
- Allow 3-5 members of the MC faculty or staff to attend the event free of charge and bring collateral material.
- Send MC photos of your event that we can post on our website and social media.
- Send any updated addresses, phone numbers or emails that you gather to the Advancement Office.
